1.) It is my belief that the CRA, since its establishment in Los Angeles, has had a positive impact on the city. And, not just on Los Angeles - many other municipalities throughout the state have taken advantage of this process because it works. I have worked throughout my career for community-based improvements and believe the CRA has had a positive impact in Hollywood, North Hollywood, Koreatown downtown and many other areas of the Los Angeles.
